

## Rules of the Cortina360 Tennis

1. Given that the practice of tennis is a potentially dangerous sport, all players are held to scrupulously observe the rules set out below.
2. The practice of tennis at Cortina360 is permitted after having read and accepted these regulations.
3. Access to the courts, the Gymnasium and the changing rooms is permitted only during the opening hours, which will be displayed both outside and inside the facility premises, on the website [www.cortina360.it](http://www.cortina360.it) and on the Cortina360 Google page.
4. Access is only possible if in possession of the appropriate badge or daily pass which will be provided at the secretary's office or at the cash desk after acceptance of these regulations. This badge or day pass is personal and non-transferable.

## Regulations for the Cortina360 Tennis

1. Access to the tennis courts is permitted only to those who have registered with Cortina360, made a reservation and are in possession of a receipt issued by Cortina360.
2. Reservations can be made on the website [www.cortina360.it](http://www.cortina360.it) or by telephone nr: +393347972372 and can be booked for a maximum of three hours on your name. Once the booking has been made, you will be able to access new bookings. In the event of non-attendance at the booked time, the guest who made the booking will not be able to make any further bookings until the missed appointment has been settled.
3. In the event of the camp being closed due to force majeure, the booking will be cancelled and guests will be able to make new bookings.
4. The operator may allow the activity of one or more instructors in a manner to be defined by the parties concerned. Persons not authorised by the manager may not give paid lessons on the tennis courts.
5. Access to the courts is only permitted for players and possibly the referee.
6. The players are responsible for any material damage caused to the playing facilities. Any damage caused must be reported to the manager immediately.
7. The playing time is 55 minutes to allow the players to tidy up the court by means of the levelling mat. Those who continue to play beyond the playing time are obliged to pay for the next hour.
8. Smoking is prohibited on the courts.
9. Animals are not allowed in the camps.
10. The tennis players' clothing on the courts must be appropriate and decent. In particular, shoes must be strictly suitable for the clay court so as not to damage the surface. It is not permitted to play in swimming costumes or bare-chested.
11. Proper behaviour must be maintained during playing hours; no shouting or inappropriate language likely to cause disturbance to other players is permitted.
12. The tennis courts may, subject to notice on the notice board, occasionally be closed or partially closed (courses, events, etc.) without this leading to a reduction in the subscription price.
13. The management does not assume the obligation and responsibility for the safekeeping of materials and any other goods or personal effects while people are in the facilities.
14. Animals cannot enter the play areas; they can only stay in the outdoor area and the bar area.
15. It is the right of the staff in charge to remove anyone from the areas who behaves in a manner deemed non-compliant with the provisions of these regulations.
16. Please do not change outside the changing rooms. The changing room must be left clean; the only exception, if you wish, you can change the shoes, which may be done just before entering the courts.
17. The consumption of food within the camps is forbidden. The waste disposal buckets located in the communal areas must be used.
18. The consumption of food in the bar is permitted. Please do not consume packed lunches. No glass containers are allowed for drinks in the entire centre.
19. During activity in the camps each visitor must adopt a polite, diligent and hygienic behaviour in order to avoid risks to themselves and others.
20. It is forbidden to carry out any activity inside the courts that is incompatible with the game of tennis; it is also forbidden to smoke and use musical equipment.
21. It is required to enter the courts wearing tennis shoes.
22. During opening hours, there will be our staff on the premises to assist and supervise. Climbers are also obliged to follow the instructions of the staff in charge in order to ensure maximum safety when climbing.
23. Minors must be accompanied and assisted by an adult who has signed the acceptance of these regulations, or by one of the instructors. The adult will have full responsibility for the minor and shall supervise his/her every action to ensure that this regulation is observed and that he/she does not incur any possible accidents.
24. Those who have signed and agreed to the regulations may accompany a companion subject to full assumption of responsibility (complete the appropriate form).
25. Yelling is forbidden.
26. Instructors and teachers not employed by the Centre must not occupy areas other than those assigned to them. The course instructor assumes responsibility for his whole group.
27. Equipment - if rented at the Centre - must be returned in a regular and complete manner, and notice must be given in the event of an accident or malfunction.
28. For hire we require a guarantee, (document) with which we ensure the return of the material; otherwise, we will make a theft report.

29. In the event of loss, admission cards are replaced. We do not replace lost day passes.
30. The participant expressly exonerates Cortina360 Srl from any responsibility for damages that may be caused to him/her as a result of his/her tennis activity or collaboration and assistance in the tennis activity of others and is solely responsible for those damages that may be caused to other frequenters of the courts.
31. For security reasons, the sports facility is equipped with a series of cameras.

### **Timetables and booking procedures**

32. The courts are available to players from 8.00 A.M. to 8.00 P.M. and can be booked online digital system at [www.cortina360.it](http://www.cortina360.it), by telephone at 3347972372, or at the Cortina360, bar and office.
33. The field with lighting, for evening use, can only be booked for 2h (20.00-22.00) at the price indicated.
34. The visibility of the scoreboard is weekly, with the possibility of booking for a maximum of 3 hours.
35. Booked hours cannot be cancelled. They must be paid the first time you present yourself at the office before you can access the tennis courts.
36. Rates will be displayed on the website [www.cortina360.it](http://www.cortina360.it), in the secretary's office and at the bar area of the Cortina360 gym.
